
Dear Ms. Foritano:

Another twenty days have passed since my January 4 letter to you, and I have not heard anything from you in response. I enclose a courtesy copy of that letter for your easy reference. I cannot fathom why you will not provide me with the basic information I have requested.

Consider the situation if our roles were reversed. Would you not want to know that kind of information about the organization that claims to speak for you regarding governance of Hansville? Would you not want to know that information, when you learn that the County has designated that organization as the primary voice of the Hansville area community? Would you not expect, quite reasonably, that that organization would willingly and promptly provide that information to you when you requested it?

I am sure that GHAAC's legal counsel would strongly encourage you to provide the requested information, for both practical and legal reasons. That person also would surely tell you that the minimal burden of providing the information I have requested pales in comparison to having to provide it in the context of a lawsuit, where you would have to give a deposition under oath and not only provide the information, but explain why you did not provide it sooner in response to the multiple written inquiries you had received.

Second, my letter also asked for the following information:


1. Where can I find a list of GHAAC members, and of who represents what sub-area?
