Dear Mr. Hostvedt:

This letter is in response to your request on December 3, 2007 for information regarding the Hood Canal Drive area and a phony speed limit sign. I am going to go through each request that you have made in the email request sent to our office. If I inadvertently miss something, please feel free to let me know.

On December 3, 2007 you requested "...the same traffic patrol and citation info for November that you provided for October." There were no citations issued in the area.

Your request for "...when the phony 25 mph signs were posted in Hood Canal Drive between Cliffside Road and the hairpin turn..." We do not have any documents about this request. Kitsap County Public Works may have documents about it. You can contact them at (360) 337-5777.

We do not have any documents regarding your request about any other government agency being involved in placing the sign.

There was not a criminal investigation concerning the signs done by our office.

You requested "...all records pertaining to those false traffic signs and copies of any citations issued on that stretch of road during the time the false speed limit was posted...". Please tell us for what timeframe you want copies of traffic citations and infractions. We can then provide the documents to you. I believe that LT Collings requested this timeframe from you in her email response on December 10, 2007.

We do not have any documents about "...getting money back from the courts...". LT Collings also answered your questions regarding "...getting money back from the courts and clearing driving records..." You may get answers directly from Kitsap County District Court at (360) 337-7109 or the Department of Licensing or an attorney.
