When you get a minute, could you take a look at the attached 2 documents. I am drafting the letter to the Hansville residents about the 2 stop signs on Ponderosa. These documents provide the information that we've gathered to use in making this determination.

If we put in the stop signs I really doubt that it will make it any safer out there, but I did find a statement in a 1994 ITE document that said they haven't found good research data that definitively shows an increase in accidents at unwarranted stop signs. But the article does go on to say that unwarranted stop signs do open the door for liability claims. For that reason, I don't feel comfortable putting up the stop signs on my word alone.
